

Get Involved

Edgemere Park is a vibrant neighborhood with a strong association that continually strives to make it even better. To immediately feel a part of the community, meet many neighbors and make new friends, consider taking part in neighborhood association decisions, operations and/or improvement projects.

Edgemere Park Preservation, Inc. (EPPI) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. A twenty-four-member Board of Trustees is responsible for running the organization, along with a President, President-Elect, Past President, Secretary and Treasurer. Each of the nineteen blocks in Edgemere Park is represented by a trustee on the board and there are five additional trustees selected at large. Terms are for two years and the board meets monthly except in July and December.

EXPECTATIONS FOR EDGEMERE PARK TRUSTEES

- Attend Trustee meetings
- Serve on at least one committee
- Actively participate in and support at least one event hosted by EPPI

Alternatively, consider participating on one of **EPPI's committees:**

Communications - produces the quarterly newsletter and other neighborhood mailings as needed, maintains the Website and social media accounts.

Historic Preservation - educates and works with residents on HP issues; coordinates with the City and Historic Preservation Commission.

Neighborhood Improvements – includes lighting, signs and other capital improvements and may involve communication with the City and contractors, and project supervision.

Park & Landscaping - includes landscaping, improvements and maintenance in the park and other public areas; coordinates with the City and contractors.

Public Relations - recognizes and welcomes new residents, Yard of the Month award and neighborhood promotion.

Resource Development – identifies and pursues potential sources of income; works with other committees to develop fundraising goals and plans.

Security Corporation - oversees contract for neighborhood security patrol and promotes membership.

Social - coordinates all neighborhood special events including 4th of July picnic, Octoberfest and Holiday party.
